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How schools' funding is set

- DfE provides DSG funding to Hertfordshire CC
- Consultation with Schools Forum on split between schools, High Level Needs and Early Years, and on schools funding formula
- Maintained schools then funded by formula by HCC
- Academies funded by EFA, using county formula



Hertfordshire DSG 2015/16

- £699m Schools Block
- £96m High Level Needs
- £63m Early Years



Financial outlook for 2016/17 and later years -- National

- Flat cash per pupil for schools
- "Plan on flat cash" for High Level Needs
- Wait for Spending Review for Early Years

.....and eventually a "national funding formula"



Financial outlook for 2016/17 and later years -- Hertfordshire

Cost pressures next year:

- £9m Inflation
- £3m Teachers pensions full year effects
- £11m National Insurance
- £5m other

Offset by savings of £5m, so net £23m



Financial outlook for 2016/17 and later years -- Hertfordshire

Cost pressures in future for schools:

- Pay and inflation
- National Living Wage
- Ending of use of carry-forwards -- £10m next year



Financial outlook for 2016/17 and later years -- Hertfordshire

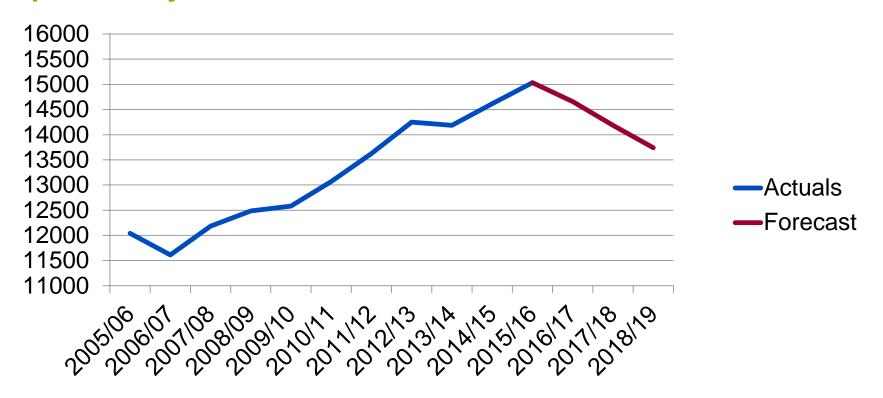


What's happened so far?

- Substantial number of secondary schools in inyear deficit this year – including all maintained secondary schools
- Substantial number of secondary schools expect to end the year in deficit
- Primary position much less pressured, but problems arising for the future
- Low rolls an important factor but not only one
- Cuts to 6th form funding

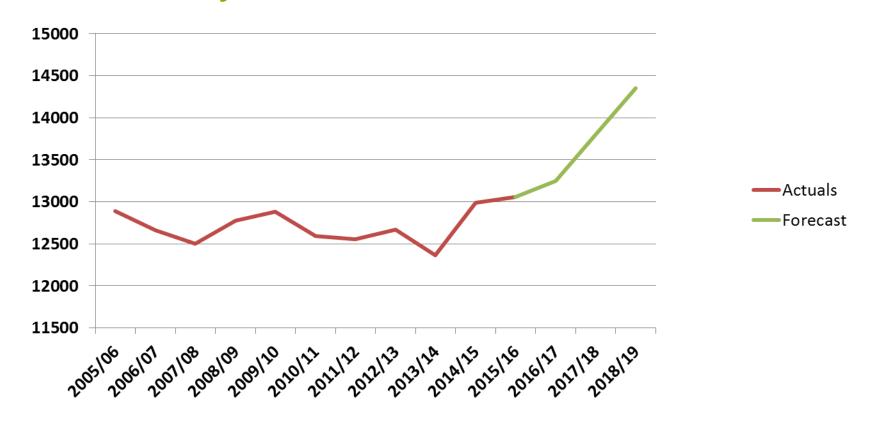


Outlook for next year and beyond – primary rolls

- Multi-academy Trusts
- Benchmarking for school budgets
- Review of school staffing and organisational structures – Business Partner provision

HfL will provide advice on options and support to schools in considering changes



Implications for Governors

Working with your Head

- Plan ahead financially
- Consider your choices
- Maintain reasonable balances we recommend 2% for maintained schools



If things go wrong – Maintained Schools

- Make sure HCC knows if you expect to go into deficit at year-end
- HCC will ensure you do not run out of cash, whilst we discuss the possibility of a loan or licensed deficit, and the action/recovery plans that go with it



If things go wrong - Academies

- Make sure you understand the constraints placed on Academy Trusts in relation to insolvency
- EFA offers loans in some circumstances
